- October 7, 2022 is the start date for requiring criminal background checks of all applicants for privilege to practice

 - The National Registry will post information to the website
 - Fingerprinting will only apply to new participants beginning October 7, 2022; those currently in the database will not be required to be fingerprinted

- Chair Schmider asked Manz to reach out to Commissioners to determine number of individuals certified and put on the website to show national impact of the Compact

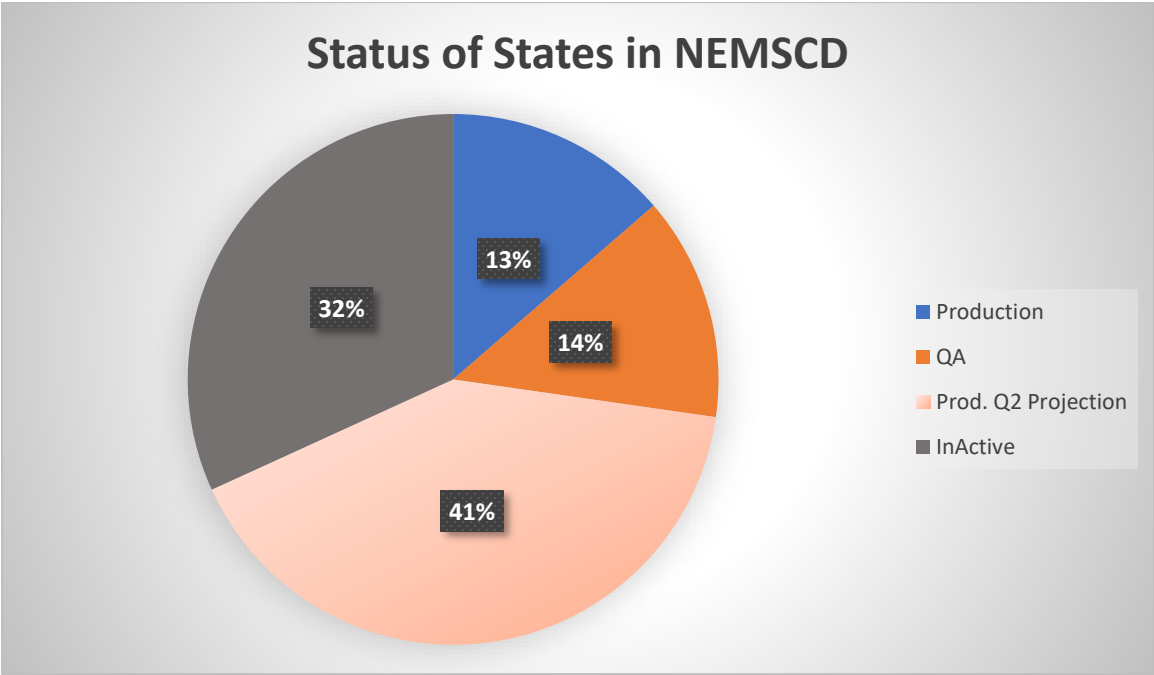

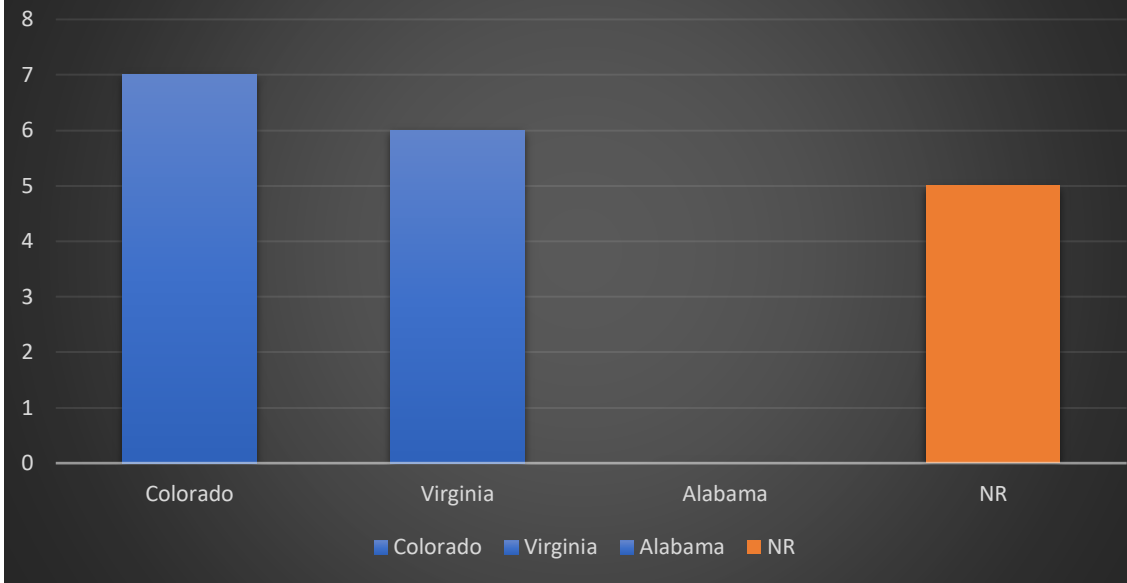
National EMS Coordinated Database

Users in Production NEMSCD



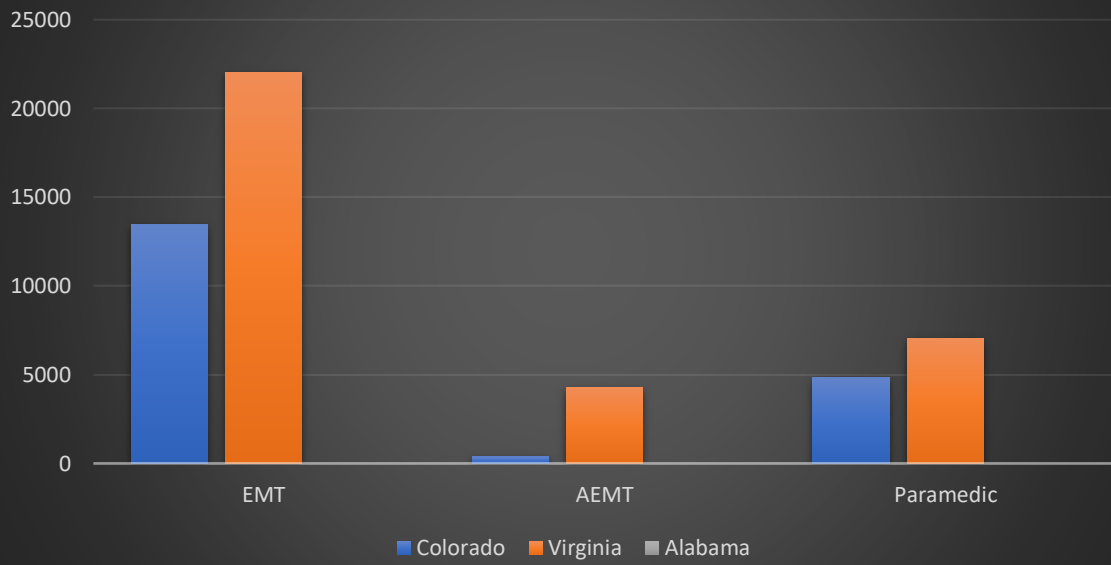
Colorado NEMSCD Data make up
